

TOPIC: LIVING THE LIFE OF FAITH I

TEXT: GALATIANS 2:20

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. KJV

TOPIC: LIVING THE LIFE OF FAITH II

TEXT: HEBREWS 11:4

By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh. KJV

How do you live by the faith of the son of God, who loved you and gave himself for you? Do you agree that this is something that you should understand, in order to be able to fully walk in the light of it? What was Apostle Paul's intention when he made this declaration? We can only give answer to the word of God through the word of God. I have realised that his statement is the truth that surrounds our work in the Lord and walk with him.

Faith is acting in accordance to God's words, his view, mandate or purpose. Let me remind you that last month we established that there is faith in the natural things that we do daily. And faith is accessible to even the unsaved. However, faith for salvation is different as it is sustained by the power of God towards the things of God in Christ Jesus. Thus, the faith of the son of God as declared in Galatians 2:20 refers to the faith of God or the God kind of faith, which not only saves a man but also sustains his walk with and in the Lord.

Of a truth, the born again man must realise that his life is spiritual though he is living it out naturally. He is a man of faith whose dictates are born out of the knowledge of God, yet he interacts with the natural world. Therefore, there is need to efficiently and effectively walk in line with God's will even as he walks and lives naturally.

We learnt of Abel, who, in his physical state, offered an offering unto God, which has a spiritual connotation. That offering though natural to the eyes; however, God's interest was the spiritual import of what was done. Such that, his offering was reckoned with much more than that of his brother. The word of God established that he brought his offering unto God by faith. It was referred to as a more excellent sacrifice. Which means that whatever a man does outside faith is not excellent. For it is written, without faith, it is impossible to please God.

Though murdered, his blood spoke and required judgement. Because God considered his offering a righteous one as it was done by faith. Dear child of God, you are living an entirely spiritual life that is of the faith of the son of God. Your advantage is to understand this truth without confusion and leverage on it to interact with the physical, natural world. This doesn't mean that you will have to suspend your sense of reasoning, not at all. But it means that you will reason in line with your identity, and be able to decipher the natural from the spiritual; and know when to superimpose the spiritual over the natural, and when to deal with the natural with the five senses. It will enable you to be a man skillful in the knowledge of his will.

PRAYER

Thank you, Lord. You are the very essence of my living. I give you all the glory because you are willing and able to train my mind to think your thoughts and know your ways. Therefore, I ask that you saturate my heart with the understanding of your will in Jesus' name. Amen

TOPIC: LIVING THE LIFE OF FAITH III

TEXT: HEBREWS 11:5

By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. KJV

Faith is practical. It's a life to be lived daily. The child of God is expected by the dictate of God to live and walk by faith. We can take a cue from the man Enoch, who had the testimony that he pleased God. The first record about his life was his walk with God. Many of us talk about walking with God but do we really understand what it means to walk with God? Are you certain that your decisions and preconception daily are a result of your understanding from walking with God?

Again, we can find the answer to what it means to walk with God from the lifestyle of Enoch. We don't have details of his life recorded in the Bible, however, we have the written testament that he was a man who was known by God and God was pleased with him, so much that he refused him to die physically. God translated or transported him. Thus, to walk with God can simply be referred to as to *please God*. How do you please God? Hebrews 11:6 is the answer, let's read;

But without faith it is impossible to [walk with God and] please Him, for whoever comes [near] to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He rewards those who [earnestly and diligently] seek Him. Hebrews 11:6 AMP

If without faith, we can't please God, definitely, to please God will mean to live by faith. Whatever is done by faith in him, is pleasing to him. Therefore, to walk with God is to walk by faith in him and in his name; in his power and in his word. This means that you can observe your life and will be able to determine how far you have been able to walk with God by how much you please him in your dispositions and decisions daily.

This means that, all that you have done either recently or in the past through the knowledge of his word and his power is the sum total of your walk with God. And all that you have done either in the past or recently outside his word and power, account for your failure to walk with him. Walking with God is not a literal walk like a man walking on his two legs. It is spiritual and simply lay emphasis on how you coordinate your life before him as his child.

It's okay to take a time off, examine your life and make amends where necessary. Hence forth, make a renewed commitment to please God. I have decided to ensure that whatever I will do and whatever decision I will make must be by the understanding of his words. It must be by faith because this is the only way to please God.

PRAYER

Father, I ask that you forgive me of every act of faithlessness that I have assumed to be a walk with you. Have mercy upon me my Lord and God. Be gracious to me and help me to keep my heart stayed on your will, that I may live by faith, and do that which is pleasing before you all the days of my life in Jesus' name. Amen

TOPIC: LIVING THE LIFE OF FAITH IV

TEXT: HEBREWS 11:7

By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith. KJV

Another practical example of a man who by the knowledge of God's words (faith) took the step to do what the Lord asked of him is Noah. I love the Amplified version of Noah's walk with God. Let's read;

By faith [with confidence in God and His word] Noah, being warned by God about events not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his family. By this [act of obedience] he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness which comes by faith. Hebrews 11:7 AMP

Noah had confidence in God which is the same as confidence in his word. For it is totally erroneous to claim to have faith in God and not have faith in his words. When God demand of him to make an ark, he was able to go ahead with this because of his faith in God. Noah pleased God because all that he did in building and preparing the ark was based on his trust in God. He revered God. He honor him such that he could do as he was commanded.

Faith will also mean to honour and reverence God in our lives daily. We can also define walking with God as honouring and reverencing God. The next time you decide to evaluate your walk with God, just go through your decisions, actions and inactions. All that you did in honour to God's name and glory is your walk with him and all that is in contrast to his honour and reverence is your walk without him.

It's time to make corrections. You will agree with me that we can't continue without a decisive step to ensure that our lives daily is in honour and reverence of God. Before you start looking for strange instructions, start with what is written in the word of God. Begin to acknowledge with the whole of your heart God's written instructions. Make up your mind to do them and ask for his grace to live by his words. When you begin to do this, it will mark a difference in your life.

Let it be your desire to please God. Let it be a desire that burns in your heart daily.

PRAYER

Father, here I am, full of weaknesses, shortcomings and incapacities. Please, take me over completely. Help me to desire to walk and please you in all my dealings and doings. Help me to truly and sincerely seek to obey your word and do your will. Just as Noah, help me to reverence and honour you without any strand of dishonesty in Jesus' name. Amen

TEXT: HEBREWS 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please him : for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. KJV

This verse popped up again in my heart and I realise that the only template that God has to reach out to men whom he created in his image and likeness is Faith. Take faith out of the picture, God is assumed to be dead and not in existence. No man will be able to acknowledge or reach out to him as a supernatural being without faith. Thus, faith become the lifeline that makes man to recognise God for his true identity.

Therefore, faith is the ladder that men walk upon to reach out to God and he does the same to us. You are able to draw nigh to God only by faith. That unexplainable yet vivid desire that acknowledges the existence of God and his awesome power is the work of faith. Faith is quite immaterial yet it does produce material things. Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear. KJV

And in the world is heaven and earth which defines the space of invisible being and visible beings. Also, it is by faith that we are able to accept that material world was created out of immaterial world.

Faith is deeply spiritual. Thus, God is infused in faith, revealed by faith and trusted by the capacity of faith. Therefore, it makes much sense to tell any man that God can only be reached from the point that you begin to believe that he exists. This is always the basis for everyman. However, for the Christian, the truth is that God who made all things is the same God who came as human to live on earth in the person of Jesus. Our faith recognises God beyond creation, it knows him as the very life that has no end.

John 17:3 says; And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. John 17:3 KJV

Living the life of faith is in the true God and Jesus Christ, whom he sent. This is the ever living substance that keeps reinforcing the efficacy of your trust in the Lord as a believer.

TOPIC: LIVING THE LIFE OF FAITH VI

TEXT: HEBREWS 11:27

By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible. KJV

Hebrews 11:23 tells us that Moses' life, starting from his birth was by faith. His parent was bold against the commandment of the king to find a means to keep their child alive against all odds because they trusted in the living God who is able to keep watch over his own elect.

The wisdom displayed by his mother and sister must have been by God. Who could have taught that a woven basket will keep a child safe and lead him to his preserved destiny? Yet, in these things, Moses was raised by his mother, who feigned as a nurse, paid for nurturing her own son and he was fed with the right understanding of his identity as those who are God's covenant people.

Moses grew, Hebrews 11:24-26 says, he refused to be called by the name of Pharaoh, he choose to suffer the affliction with the righteous because he esteemed the reproach of Christ as great riches. This was all by faith. You can summarize Moses' life from childhood to adulthood as a life lived by faith. In the midst of adversity and sharp discontention as regards his identity, he was able to stand and trust God.

Hebrews 11:27 unveil the secret that sustain his action, it says; By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: **for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.**

Moses' gaze was on him who is invisible. His parent wasn't there anymore to defend or dictate his actions. He took his destiny in his hands, haven learned of the God of Israel, who is veiled to the physical eyes, yet alive forevermore. Moses saw him who is invisible and believed completely, such that, he refused what seems to be obtainable and fled to take hold on a refuge that is invisible.

Thus, when the Lord revealed himself to him in the appearance of fire, haven the bush burn and not consumed, Moses, turned, moved closer and behold the mystery that was happening because he has always trust in God, whose existence is wrapped up in mysteries. Do not shrink in the face of adversity and opposition. Your destiny is in the hands of the Lord.

Keep your gaze on him who is invisible, keep him alive in your heart, trusting wholly that he is a God of faith. Always reach out to him by faith, don't ever allow the fire of your faith to dim at any cost. Fan your faith to flame.

TOPIC: LIVING THE LIFE OF FAITH VII

TEXT: JOSHUA 1:8

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. KJV

We have the testament of men who lived and walk on earth, trusting absolutely in God. They have the record that they pleased God in the way they lived their lives daily, coordinating it in accordance to God's words. After Moses' death, the baton fell on Joshua, who have the record of a walk and life of faith.

In association with Caleb, they obeyed the instruction of Moses with ten other men, who might be considered as leaders or men who are believed to have learn the ways of God. Thus, Moses sent them to spy the land, which God has given his word of promise to give unto them. They came back with two different perspective to what God has said in relation to what they saw.

It is true that the land was a good land. Flowing with milk and honey. A land which the eyes of the Lord is upon from morning till night, filled with treasures and great wealth. It is also a fact that the children of Anak and Amalekites, mighty and giant in stature, were there. They reported what they saw, however, majority of them missed the mark. By what they saw, they were bold to discard what the Lord had said to them. Their faith disappeared with no trace. They spoke like men who have no track record of the miracles and the power of God. Their report doubted God's integrity and the camp of God's people was turn into two.

One part in fear, the other part can be considered as the minority in view of Joshua and Caleb, who still the people and declared, "We are well able to go up and take the land". Since the mouth of the Lord has spoken it, then we can do it. What these two men did was to exercise faith in God's words (promise) over physical fact. They believed in God and are certain that what he says, he can and will do. (Numbers 13:26-33)

God witnessed to Joshua's faith in him, thus, he was bold to appoint him after Moses. He knew he has a heart that follow headlong after his word even when there is no physical evidence. Thus, God spoke to him after Moses death with the truth that his ability to walk in the stead of Moses and dispense the power of God just as he has seen in his days is dependent on the book of the law. God instructed him to read and meditate in order to observe all that is written therein and be able to do likewise, for this is the only way to prosper (achieve success as a leader of God's people).

Faith is simply taking God's words as the absolute truth and stepping out to do what it says. To live by faith is to be an attendant of his words. It is to be the man or woman whose life is found in doing what God's words says to do in every circumstance.

Lord, I come before you in humility of heart, recognising that I cannot wholly obey your word without your help. Touch my life with your power and work in me the desire and ability to do as you have said and as it is written in your word in Jesus' name. Amen

TEXT: JOSHUA 1:9

Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest. KJV

Since the day, the Lord instructed Moses to appoint Joshua as leader before the people, the word of the Lord towards him was to be strong and courageous. Moses said the same the Lord told him in Joshua 1:6&9. It seems like at every sensitive junction to convey the burden of leadership to his shoulders, the word of God towards him is to be strong and courageous.

You will agree with me that it requires strength and courage to obey God's words. It takes more than will power to be able to live by his word daily. It will require more than head knowledge and logic to exercise faith daily. Since it's faith, then, it already passed the message that it will most likely negates physical realities, report and verdict. It will definitely call for God's attention with trust in God's words.

Joshua haven't led before but have walked closely with Moses, and had seen how God dealt with him and how he followed him whole heartedly. And not just this, he had also seen how God's people has constantly walked contrary to his instruction thus in every sense Joshua should be timid and afraid. But God stood with him and told him, you have the book of the law written by Moses, that's where the answer is, read it, think upon it, observe all that has been written and take it to heart to do them and lead the people to do the same. God also told him, don't fear these people, they didn't appoint or call you, so your validation is not from them. Just simply follow me and follow what has been written. What a way to encourage a man, it is in the lord by his word. Hallelujah!

Allow me to boldly declare to you today that Joshua 1:8 is as valid as it was when the Lord spoke to Joshua. It hasn't changed. To the many challenges and troubles that abound in this age, God is saying to you be strong and courageous. For your present situation that seems that life is not fair to you, God says to be strong. However, he want you to draw constant strength and courage from his word. He said, read it, think on it and do what it says, that's how you will find true joy, rest and hope.

Living by faith require strength that doesn't come from the food you eat and the water you drink. It comes from a kind of spiritual appetite that is totally centered on God's word. The more you take time to read and meditate on God's words in order to walk in the light of it, the better you are able to live by God's power daily. Faith is God in action in your everyday life.

TOPIC: LIVING THE LIFE OF FAITH IX

TEXT: HEBREWS 3:10

Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, And said, They do alway err in their heart; And they have not known my ways. KJV

What happened to the other ten spies, who brought the whole camp of Israel a contrary report, which caused the people to murmur against God and walked in unbelief? Truly, God judged them, however; the greatest lesson we should learn was God's report about their action.

God testified that they walked in unbelief. They erred in their hearts, they do not know his ways and they tempted him. He said he was grieved with that generation and as a result of this, just as they spoke in his ears he did unto them. They borne the burden of their unbelief for forty years, till that generation was wasted and their children were the ones that was led by Joshua.

In a simple word, God was against them because they failed to live by faith. They put themselves up as an enemy of God. Because a lack of faith or the inability to live by faith as a people of God will make it difficult for God's promises and word to find expression. It will mean that such people or that person as the case maybe is walking in direct opposition to who he is and what God has called them to be.

God's promise is that he will give them the land and they should go up to possess it. But by the wrong report, they decided to choose a captain and go back to Egypt. This decision and intention was in direct opposition to God's will, thus, they acted as an enemy of God. Moses referred to them as children who has no faith because they were not mindful of God's will. Let's read;

Of the Rock that begat thee thou art unmindful, And hast forgotten God that formed thee. And when the LORD saw it, he abhorred them, Because of the provoking of his sons, and of his daughters. And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: For they are a very froward generation, Children in whom is no faith. Deuteronomy 32:18-20 KJV

You don't want to be a child of God who lacks faith. Who will choose to live outside the life of faith which God has called you to live. At the end, those generation were cut short from entering into God's rest. The writer of Hebrews says that God swore in his wrath that they will not enter into his rest because of their unbelief. Living the life of faith bring you to a position of rest in God. This means that you have come to a place where your actions and decision are wholly tailored by God's view, his words, his desires and you won't act outside of what his words says.

Regardless of the physical fact, you will always exonerate God's words and instead of panicking, you will rest in the truth of his words. This is how to live the life of faith. In rest and quietness.

Thank you, Father for there is rest and by faith, I have come to that place where the intangible makes so much sense to me more than the tangible. I am able to lift the immaterial to the material world by my absolute trust in you. Help me never to be your enemy, never to walk in faithlessness in Jesus' name. Amen

TOPIC: LIVING THE LIFE OF FAITH X

TEXT: HEBREWS 3:12

Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. KJV

God swore that the generation that was led astray by the report of the ten spies will never enter into his rest and they didn't just as he has proclaimed (Hebrews 3:11, Numbers 14:23). His rest is not only referring to the land of Canaan which was their destination. In greater understanding, the writer of Hebrews unveils that the rest refers to the life of faith, lived on absolute trust in God. This life begins when a man receives salvation, however, it continues as he walks with God and learns to live by the faith that has saved him.

Thus, the rest of God is a position when man ceases from his works and God ceases from his. Let's read; For he that is entered into his rest, he also has ceased from his own works, as God did from his. KJV God is that rest where all the work of men ceases, in that they now walk and live by faith in him.

Thus, Hebrews 3:12 says that there must not be an evil heart of unbelief in any man's heart because it makes a man by his actions to depart from the Lord. And verse 13 tells us that unbelief comes as a result of the deceitfulness of sin. Which means that men walk in faithlessness when they are deceived that God will fail them and he's not worthy of their trust.

Therefore, child of God, your ability to live the life of faith is to always consider very highly the word of God and never allow deception at any time to creep into your heart, so much that you depart from the Lord in what you do and say. Rather, enjoy your restful position in the Lord. You stand by faith in Christ Jesus, walk and live by that faith. Don't allow anything to bring you to live perpetually in anxiety and unbelief.

Discard it by praying and pouring your heart to the Lord. Always ask for strength, wisdom and courage to seek the Lord in whatever situation you find yourself. Labour in prayers to maximise the benefit of the life of rest you have in Christ Jesus. Do not be quick to allow for the deception and lies of the enemy. Don't live like the ten spies who were overwhelmed by what they saw and forgot what the Lord has done with the promises in his word. If you have seen his mighty hand in your life in the past, he has not changed and he won't. Be consistent, living the life of faith.

Thank you, Father. I recognise that I am in your rest. A place of faith, love and grace. Help me to remain secure and stable in this rest and keep me from the wicked one who seeks to steal my joy and my confidence in your word in Jesus' name. Amen

TEXT: PSALMS 1:2

But his delight is in the law of the LORD ; And in his law doth he meditate day and night. KJV

It's beautiful to note and acknowledge that the book of Psalms started with the same words of assurance to Joshua. He described a man who will live a diligent and conscious life because he is named after God. Scripture calls him a blessed man. His blessings aren't riches or anything of this material world but the intangible blessings of God that abound in the spirit, which surpasses all things.

This blessed man was described as one who will not receive or act on the counsel of the ungodly, nor walk in the ways of sinners neither sit in the seat of the scornful but will do just one thing, which is to meditate in the law of the Lord because it is his delight. This implies that the law of the Lord must be a delight to anyone who will meditate on it. He must consider it necessary and of utmost importance, that's when he will give his time to think and consider the word in order to observe to do all that is written therein.

Just as the Lord told Joshua that by doing all that is written in the law as a prerequisite to his success, is the same way this blessed man was described. The spirit of faith is centered on the utterance that proceeds from the mouth of the child of God which depicts that he or she truly believed in the word of God and is able to take the next step by his or her irrevocable boldness and trust in God. What you say can either connote fear, uncertainty or faith.

2Corinthians 4:13 says; We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak; KJV

In our text above, we see David, the youngest child of Jesse, the Ephratithe of Bethlehem Judah, spoke as one who have knowledge of God and his power. No one told him that the words and boasting of Goliath of Gath, the champion of the host of the Philistines was a taunt and shame to the name of God. He also understood, that physically are men of wars, fighting as the soldiers of Isreal under the kingship of Saul; However, he knew that their identity are the armies of the living God. Thus he spoke;

... Who is this uncircumcised Philistines that he should defy the armies of the living God?"

One might think this statement from the mouth of David, was only spoken out of his head knowledge. But he repeated the same, when they rehearsed before the ears of the King, his declaration and the King Saul sent for him. He said; Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies of the living God. 1 Samuel 17:36 KJV

With no doubt, David knew exactly what he was talking about. And by his words, it was recognisable that he knew God as the living one and the men of war as the armies of the living God. By his words, he pitched Goliath against God and had the confidence that God will fight against whosoever that seems to exonerate himself above him or his people. What a depth of revelation and understanding!

David spoke faith filled words because he believed. You can't trust God and his words and speak contrary to your faith. It's very important that your speech and conversation connotes the depth of trust you have in God by his word. He who believes speaks faith filled words.

Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied. TOPIC: THE SPIRIT OF FAITH V

TEXT: MARK 11: 22

And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. KJV

The story that led Jesus to make this declaration which we can refer to as an instruction to his disciples, was when he came from Bethany and would go to Jerusalem. On the way, he saw a fig tree, which by its leaves seems to have fruits on it but haven gotten to it, Jesus realised that it has no fruits: He cursed the fig tree and went on his way with his disciples. However, Peter among others took note of his actions. (Mark 11:12-14)

On their way back from Jerusalem, they passed through the same place where the fig tree was. Suddenly, Peter noticed that the fig tree had withered away. He called Jesus' attention saying; Master; 'behold the fig tree which thou cursed is withered away'. Then Jesus responded to him, saying; **Have faith in God**

The Amplified version gave us the picture of what kind of faith Jesus was referring to. Let's read; Jesus replied, **Have faith in God [constantly]**. Mark 11:22 AMP This means that Jesus referred to the need to have a constant, consistent and an everyday assurance in God. This is achieved when we acknowledge that God is faithful and can be trusted. And also realise that because we are able to express faith yesterday as regarding a thing, does not outrightly mean that we have the same level of faith today to address a similar situation or another.

Therefore, it is important to always fan to flame our assurance in God. And how do we achieve this? By feeding our heart and saturating it with the word of God and by also speaking it forth and meditating on it regularly. The Spirit of faith enables you to constantly receive the direction of God's word, even as you declare his truth with your lips.

Don't forget that the spirit of faith in you speaks. It quickens you to speak and not just to act unresponsive to God's word. You will notice that Jesus spoke to the fig tree, and that which he said came to pass. But there must have been an ability or power in his spirit that sponsor his attitude to speak. That's the Spirit of faith. Jesus knew that whatsoever he says by faith, will take place without hesitation.

You need to get to that point in your walk with the Lord, where you have stored up God's word in your spirit, knowing that whenever you speak by faith as touching anything, with absolute assurance in the Lord, it will come to pass. This is not the time to close your mouth, but to speak with boldness that is stirred up with assurance in God.

PRAYER

Thank you Father for by your word, I have received the understanding that my words, when it is backed up by faith and faith filled utterances, it carries power and ability to materialise. Lord, I ask that you help me to maintain a constant trust in you and your words and be able to respond to the impulses of the Spirit of faith by speaking boldly to situation and circumstances to bow to the power of God in Jesus' name. Amen

TOPIC: THE SPIRIT OF FAITH VI

TEXT: MARK 11:23

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. KJV

Haven told Peter to have faith in God, Jesus proceeded to reveal the truth embedded in the ability to speak forth God's word and desires which will come to pass. He said “, Whosoever shall say to this mountain". What you say is the secret behind the victory, expectation or that which will take place. Because Jesus said to the fig tree to dry up, it came to pass.

Remember, the spirit of faith speaks because it believes. Thus, it is expected that you speak and make declaration to whatever thing that stood as mountain: Without doubt in your heart, you will have whatsoever you have declared. This brings us to another important truth. When you speak, you must not allow or entertain fear or doubt in your heart but must believe that whatsoever you say shall come to pass. Then, you will have whatsoever you have said.

It is important to note the procession of this revelation as Jesus explained to Peter. First, you should have a constant faith in God. Then, say or speak to the mountain, after which you believe absolutely even as you have declared and lastly you live with expectation to behold what you have said by faith in the Lord.

The Spirit of faith speaks with expectation. You don't declare God's words and live as usual. You must bear about in your heart, the expectation of that which you have said by faith. There is the need to carry the consciousness of an absolute positivity of that which you have said, then you will have what you have declared in the light of his word.

This also means that God has left you with the ability to decide what mountain stays in your life and that which must not stay. And in my opinion, I don't think you should allow any mountain to take root in your life. You must pull them down by speaking to it. Address it with God's word, through your absolute reliance on him and expect your declarations to find expression against the mountain by the power of God. The Spirit of Faith will guide you to keep speaking and not give up your trust in God and his word.

PRAYER

In the name of Jesus, I speak to my life, my family, career and ministry, that you yield your fruits to me in abundance and I will never lose nothing. I speak also by the power in the name of Jesus that whatsoever that stand as a mountain functioning against the will of God for me is crumbled and shattered into dust in Jesus' name. Amen

TEXT: MARK 11:25

And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. KJV

Aren't you surprised that haven explained the blessing and right of speaking by faith and praying to receive desires, Jesus went on to unveil more about this blessings in the Lord God. He said with the prayer of faith comes the need to forgive by faith. This means that forgiveness is positively correlated with prayer.

When you pray, then you forgive. As beautiful and promising prayer is, which is done by faith, in accordance to how Jesus described it, it will be non-effective and can be render outrightly useless when clouded or clothed with unforgiveness. Jesus simply said in one word that prayer and forgiveness, goes hand in hand. They are like bread and butter or bread with beans, either one that you prefer. A man who stands before God to pray must have learn to forgive. God is bound to fulfil your expectation from him, when you are willing, knowing that you are able to fulfil the expectation of others by quickly letting go of a wrong or offense done against you.

Another thing you must observe is that, Jesus didn't ask who was guilty or how did the offense emerge neither did he ask to know about the matter, so that he can judge rightly, who should be the first to plead and make reconciliation. He simply gave the command or the instruction on forgiveness. This should tell you that God isn't concerned about the issue, his earnest desire is to ensure that you are saved from the web that offense which causes unforgiveness in your heart have created for you, inorder to take away or hinder your desires in prayer, even though you pray by faith and are still in faith.

He used the phrase "If ye have ought against any". Which means as long as you acknowledge a wrong deed and you are dissatisfied about it, don't brush it aside because it is important to your prayer. God is looking straight into your heart and can see that there is a thing against your prayer and it's offense. He said, take it away immediately. Don't leave it there. It's dangerous to your miracle and desires. Forgive the offender immediately. Take away the issue completely and expect your desires to be met.

Is Jesus partial? No, he isn't. He wants you to be delivered from pride and insensitivity to spiritual things. You have the ability to forgive even without the other party asking for forgiveness. Jesus is teaching you selflessness and simplicity. Please, learn from him.

PRAYER

Thank you, Father for you will yet help me in all my endeavours. I ask for the grace to be able to let go of offense quickly and willingly. Let it be difficult to sacrifice my prayer on the altar of offense. Help me to prioritise the effectiveness of my prayer above resentment, anger and offense in Jesus' name. Amen

TEXT: JEREMIAH 17:5

Thus saith the LORD ; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD . KJV

We must not trivialize the state of our heart before the Lord. To live the life of faith or to live by faith, the beginning is from our heart. If you observed keenly, you will realise that in Mark 11: 23, when we study that the Spirit of faith, speaks the word of faith through Jesus' instruction to his disciples as regards the fig tree that dried up in accordance to Jesus' declaration against it; a distinct instruction is to say to the mount without doubting. Let's read the text again;

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; **and shall not doubt in his heart**, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Mark 11:23 KJV

Therefore, what you say is affected by what you believe in your heart. It's possible to say a thing and the heart is not in resonance with what is being said. This negates the workings of the Spirit of faith. It simply reveals that such heart is not full or filled with faith. The mouth says it but the heart negates it. Therefore, such declaration is nothing but mere words which will not yield any result.

In the light of this truth, God spoke through prophet Jeremiah, to establish that the man who trust in the words of another man, and make the arm of flesh his hope, allowing his heart to depart from the Lord is cursed. Why is he cursed? Because his trust (expectation, belief, faith) is not in the Lord. His heart is not right or not where it should be. Such man lives in doubt, lack of faith towards God but is only persuaded on what he can see, feel and touch physically, neglecting the ways and direction of the unseen God, which is faith and absolute trust in him.

You don't want to be a child of God, who only profess God with his lips and merely mouth the word of God and whose heart is totally departed from him. Always doubting his words and not in submission to his will. The Lord says such is cursed. This doesn't mean that God placed a curse on him or her but that such is out of the reach where the help of God can find him or her. Because his heart has departed from faith. Read Jeremiah 17:6 to understand how the life of such man was described by the Lord. You don't want to be like that, therefore, let your heart be full of faith. For it is the power of God to live on earth.

PRAYER

Thank you, Father. I ask for strength and grace to have a single heart and mind before you. Help me to fully trust in your word and exercise a heart filled with faith and power not doubting the potency of your word and name in Jesus' name. Amen

TEXT: HEBREWS 3:12

The word of God established that when the heart of a man depart from the Lord it is as a result of unbelief and such heart is referred to an evil heart as seen in our text above (Hebrews 3:12). The expectation of the Lord is that through your dependence and total reliance on his word, your heart will be stirred up in absolute trust in him continually. Such that you will be able to speak and make declarations in accordance to his word by the Spirit of faith in you.

2Peter 1:3 says that God has given to us all that we need to live a dynamic life here on earth, while we flourish through the strength of his words. Let's read; For His divine power has bestowed on us [absolutely] everything necessary for [a dynamic spiritual] life and godliness, through true and personal knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. 2 Peter 1:3 AMP

Therefore, your life is wholly a result of how far you have been able to engage the knowledge of God through the knowledge of his word. This will keep your heart full of faith towards him and also keep you within the reach of God's help. You will see good when it comes and you will not live in a parched land, waste place or in the wilderness. You will be fat and flourishing.
