TOPIC: THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL I

TEXT: ROMANS 1:1

Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God, KJV

Welcome to the month of October. It's our Independent day in Nigeria. And we thank God for his mercies over our nation. Why not take some time to give thanks to God because the nation has not been consumed, despite all that has happened this year. It is true that there are a number of dissatisfaction, however, God has sustained you thus far. Remember that last month we received the wisdom of the Lord to pray in affliction; therefore, the right attitude that we should have towards our nation at this time is to pray. The word of God to us in this month will revolve round the essence of our lives as believers. The gospel is totally centered on the revelation of Jesus, born as a man, was crucified, died and buried, and was raised from the dead by the power of God through the working of the Holy Spirit.. Upon this, grace and faith was brought forth to all men who believe that Jesus came in the flesh, was put to death by cruxification, was raised from the dead and He is alive forever more.

As literal and simple this is, it is the entire truth that constitute the gospel upon which the hope of believers are built through the faith that has been expressed. The gospel speaks volume of a hope that is alive which is resident in Christ Jesus, in that he was raised from the dead. Do you believe in the gospel wherein there is living hope?

TEXT: ROMANS 1:6

among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ: KJV

Yesterday, we started with the message of hope established in the gospel of Christ. The element that characterizes the faith of the man who believes in Jesus is upheld in the truth that Jesus was born in the flesh, he lived by the power of the Holy Spirit, was crucified, buried and was raised from the dead by the power of God. In his death and resurrection is the hope of the believer. In it is the preaching of the gospel as hope from the decay and corruption of this world.

He says; I was sent to this world to save all who have been lost and under the rulership of the devil. I was crucified to bear the pain and shame of all who are in sin and are spiritually dead. I was raised by the power of God's Spirit to establish eternal life and victory over sin who held the world in captivity. All who believe in my works will be saved and will not perish but have everlasting life.

The voice of Jesus, the savior of the world is not without a living hope. He called all men to God in reconciliation and by his death, he took away the enmity. Now, all men can come to God with the assurance of faith through Christ Jesus. The gospel is the power of God unto salvation. In it God display all his power to save the world from destruction.

Do you know that your life as a believer isn't hopeless? You are only preoccupied with earthly matters, without taking thought of the blessing of salvation and the living hope you have received in Christ Jesus. TOPIC: THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL III

TEXT: ROMANS 5:1

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: KJV

God in Christ Jesus, has called the world to himself. This is sustained by his righteousness. Romans 1:17 says that it is in the preaching of the gospel that the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith. Which means that the man who is justified from sins and death is to live by faith.

Salvation is not an afterthought of God's plan. It has been the plan from the beginning of the world. However, at the right time, God sent forth his son made in the likeness of sinful man to condemn sin in the flesh. Galatians 4:4-5 explain this truth saying; but when the fullness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. KJV

Thus, adoption was God's manner to save all who come to him through Christ Jesus' death and resurrection. Faith in Christ Jesus become the rod of justification which brought all men to be at peace with God. This doesn't mean that God is fighting with the world. It pointed to the truth that sin stood as an enemy between God and man but in redemption through Christ death and resurrection, the enemy was taken away and peace was restored. Hallelujah!

Furthermore, Romans 5:2-5 continue with the reality that as believers we now stand in faith and rejoice in this hope that we have in Christ. And because we have a living hope, we face diverse challenges, troubles, pain and affliction; yet all these things are to make us stronger because we have an unseen force in our lives. It is the power of God and his presence. Romans 5:5 says; and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. Romans 5:5 KJV

By our experiences, through the many challenges we face and was able to overcome, our hope in the Lord alone is stirred up. Thus, this hope can never allow us to be put to shame because God's love (his consistent and persistent character towards us) is shed abroad in our heart by the Holy Spirit which is given to us as a gift in salvation.

How can you quiver and shrink in face of challenges as a child of God, whose hope is alive and can never fade away? It must be that you have given up on the hope that sustain the essence of your life. Get back on track. Ruminant on the joy you have in this world that cannot be taken away from you by anyone or anything. Keep your hope alive because it is indeed a living hope.

TOPIC: THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL IV

TEXT: ROMANS 8:18

For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. KJV

The message of the gospel came with the reality of God's glory. Hebrew 1:3 describe the only begotten son of God as one in the express image of the Father and the brightness of his glory. Please read;

who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; KJV

God's glory is the expression of Christ Jesus. He is the glory of the Father. John 1:14 establish this truth about Christ Jesus, it says; and the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. KJV.

The only begotten son of God is the glory of the Father. He came with the promise of eternal life, a glory that we possess now and span to the future. Howbeit, Romans 8:18 says that we might presently be living with great distress, challenges and sufferings yet they are not to be compared with the glory that shall be revealed in us. This hope of a glory to be revealed is found in the message of the gospel. That life here on earth isn't the end of all things. We who have bear the earthly image shall bear the heavenly image..

There is a future wherein the glory that we have now as the testament of the reality of our lives becomes vivid and unending. Yet, we are not the only one who is subjected to this hope, even the creation. They all are waiting for the time when all the things we hope for in Christ Jesus are brought to reality. Romans 8:20 says the creation was subject to vanity, not willing, but it was subjected in accordance to the plan of the one who subject it in hope. Therefore, we have no reason to detest our lives. It carries the beauty and glory of God. That glory is Christ. Christ who is in you, is the glory of God whereupon your hope is built.

Let your hope be built on nothing else but Jesus blood and his righteousness. Don't trust the sweetest frame but lean totally on Jesus name. Stand on Christ the solid rock and count all other ground a sinking sand. I witness to your heart, because you have Christ, you have a hope that is beyond this present world. Hallelujah!

TOPIC: THE GOSPEL V

TEXT: ROMANS 8:22

For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. KJV

There is a connection between our redemption and the deliverance of this world. The corruption that had spread on the world which makes all things to decay and die out is actually not in God's plan from the beginning. However, with our deliverance to life comes the hope of all creation, that there will be a time of time and a season, when all things will be reconciled to its original state. Heaven will be on earth and eternal life will reign on earth. Hallelujah.

Thus Romans 8:23 says, it's not only the creation that groan and hope for this beauty and glory even we ourselves, who have the first fruits of God's spirit. Let's read; And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. KJV

The Spirit of God in our lives is a fortaste of God's glory in us. There is going to be the fullness of the taste. Thus, we are only waiting for the adoption, which is the redemption of our body. Our body haven't been redeemed yet. It is still dust, subject to physical death and pain. Yet, our Spirit is made alive, delivered from the bondage of sin, death and corruption. This is the newness of our lives in Christ Jesus.

However, this isn't all that the message of the gospel brought to us. It tells us that whosoever believes in Christ will not perish but will have everlasting life. Our present body can perish even though in our Spirit we have eternal life that isn't subject to death. Our body needs to come to that reality of eternal living. Thus, we eagerly wait and hope for the redemption of our body.

2Corinthians 5:1-5 explain this truth, it says; for we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven: if so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked. For we that are in this tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life. Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is God, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit. KJV

God is the one who set the hope of a house not made with hands, eternal in the heaven in our hearts. This is not talking about physical house (it is referring to our body, thus the word tabernacle was used) There is an earthly house of this tabernacle (our present physical body) and there is a heavenly house not made by hands, a building of God (our future eternal body). The message of the gospel speaks volume of this living hope. We have faith by the gospel not in material possessions but eternal realities and blessings. A living hope it is!

PRAYER

Thank you Lord for you have wrought in me and uncountable others who are called into your grace and glory a hope of an heavenly house not made with hands. I live daily in the fullness of this hope, knowing that my life count much more than this present time and age. Amen

TOPIC: THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL VI

TEXT: ROMANS 8:24

For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? KJV

Yes, we are saved by grace through faith which is the gift of God and no man can take this glory upon him or herself (Ephesians 2:8-9). Haven been saved by God's grace through the expression of our faith in Christ Jesus, we received the reality of a living hope. Thus, Romans 8:24 says, we are saved by hope. Which means that we are yet to become in reality all that God intend us to become presently in this world. He has saved us, transformed our lives and gave us his Spirit, yet there is more to who and what we are now than the eyes can see.

Romans 8:25 says; But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it. What is a Christian life without a living hope? Apostle Paul speaks emphatically, he said, if in this world only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable (1Corinthians 15:19). The preaching of the gospel came with a resounding message of hope not vanity. By the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, we have the hope of a life full of glory, which presently by the gift of the Holy Spirit, we have a foretaste of what it means to be saved.

The beauty of being able to commune with the unseen God. The blessedness of being able to receive miracles, wonders, and great manifestation of the Spirit. The presence of a joy that isn't subject to possession. We can vividly tell that within us, there is the power and the glory of God because we are saved by his grace through faith. Yet, this isn't all that is accounted to us in Christ. There is to come before us, a life that has no end in itself. Christ is that life that ends not. The hope of our glory, which is God's. Hallelujah!

TOPIC: THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL VII

TEXT: ROMANS 8:26

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. KJV

The Spirit of God envelopes the entire reality of the gospel. Though, we are saved by hope yet God made a down payment that we belong to him and all that the message of the gospel of Christ entails will come to pass now and entirely later. The Spirit of God in the believer is the hallmark of eternity. We are certain that we belong to him because he gave us of his Spirit.

1John 4:13-15 says; **Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit.** And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world. Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God. KJV

God gave us of his Spirit and because we have confess Jesus as the son of God and believed in him, God dwells in us and we in him. Thus, the Spirit is the presence of God's glory as seen in the face of Jesus Christ. All of God is expressed by the Spirit of God. This is what makes you a new creation in Christ Jesus. God's Spirit indwelling you.

However, God didn't give his Spirit to only express that he is in us, he gave his Spirit to supply the greatest need of man **HELP**. Man is created to need the help of God. And in the new creation, man was totally helped by God to stand firm in him and be sustained by him. Much more, the Spirit of God bears the infirmities (weaknesses, frailty) of the believer. Indeed, God testified that the Spirit makes intercession for the saints in accordance to the will of God. This doesn't mean that the Holy Spirit do your prayers for you. Not at all. It simply says that by the help of the Holy Spirit, you are able to gain strength, capacity and the ability to pray rightly and with the right words. The Spirit of God sustains you in the presence of God. How great is his steadfast help in you! Hallelujah!

TEXT: ROMANS 8:28

TOPIC: THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL IX

TEXT: ROMANS 8:29

For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. KJV

The juicy part of our lives as believers is that we are sons of God. Nothing in heaven and earth can neutralize this truth. You and I are known of God and he called us his own in his begotten Son, Jesus Christ or for better emphasis, in Christ, who was raised from the dead.

We can look at this reality which corroborates the firm hope we have received in the gospel of Christ from two perspective, First Ephesians 2:4-6 explain that God made us his son by his great love in accordance to the supernatural miracle of the resurrection of Christ from the dead, let's read:

But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: KJV

This means that with the title of the son of God comes the declaration of one who have been raised from dead and is sitted with Christ in heavenly places. This isn't a natural thing, thus, the natural mind cannot fathom it. It's purely spiritual. Therefore, Romans 8:16 says; The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: KJV

This is first our spiritual reality. And yet a hope of an eternal identity. What do I mean? Let's read 1John 3:1-3, it says; Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure. KJV

Now, we are the sons of God. Yet, all that we will look like and we are is yet to fully find expression. We look forward to seeing the one in whom we were raised from the dead, and when we see him, we shall be like him. Thus, we have a living hope and by this hope, we live a pure life. A life uncontaminated from the falsehood of the world, that thinks that everything ends at this time. No, it doesn't, it have not yet appeared what we shall be. Not until we look outwardly as he is, the best of our identity is yet to surface.

Therefore, he who conformed us to the image of his Son Jesus Christ, knew us and gave us this life, filled with hope and great expectation. You are called with a defined life, face life with hope.

PRAYER

Thank you Father for this great calling in Christ Jesus. The conformity of my life in Christ. The transformation into new creation, whose life transcend earthly living. This is heaven on earth and I am glad that heaven is now my identity and in the future my life to be lived. Amen

TOPIC: THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL X

TEXT: ROMANS 8:30

Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified. KJV

There is a predestination, upon which all men are called to salvation in Christ Jesus. 1Timothy 2:4-6 described God's predestination, saying; who (God) will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time. KJV

His desire is to have all men to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth that he has predestined, called, justified and glorify his Son first, that others may follow the same process and become like him, spiritually and afterwards physically. Jesus needed to come in the flesh because all men are already in the flesh. Hebrews 2:10-11 & 14 explain that God decided to have Jesus come in the flesh because of you and I. That in resurrection, he can become our elder brother and we can walk in the light of the deliverance he came to perfect for us in his death. Let's read;

For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren, KJV

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; Hebrews 2:14 KJV

Thus, the predestination is a fulfilled destiny in Christ death and resurrection. Yet, we have the hope of an unending rule and reign with him, we, who have been glorified through his death. Christ was raised and became the first fruit of them that was raised from death and his alive forever more. Thus, we are raised in him as the fruits that follows after him, that we might presently live by the power of the resurrected life and afterwards live forever like unto him.

God in Christ has called us to a lively hope not vanity. Let this present heaven and earth quake and quiver, there is an eternal life that we are made partaker of by the presence of the Spirit of God in us. We have a foretaste of God's glory, yet we will enjoy the fullness when mortality is swallowed up in victory. Our light affliction works for us a far more exceeding weight of glory. We cannot give up because we have a solid life and hope. We don't commit suicide, because he who gave us hope is alive in us, with us and for us. We live unto him forever.

PRAYER

Thank you Lord. I pray with absolute trust in you this morning, declaring that the challenges of this world though strong, yet, is not stronger than the reality of my identity in Christ Jesus. My life is given to me as a gift of God, therefore I cannot commit suicide for any reason. I do not lose hope regardless of the challenges and opposition. God is my life and existence, I live for him in Jesus' name. Amen

TOPIC: THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL XI

TEXT: ROMANS 8:31

What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? KJV

But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Titus 3:3-5 KJV

which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; that being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:6-7 KJV

What great goodness we have in Christ Jesus. God shed on us abundantly his power to save and deliver and made us heirs of himself according to the hope of eternal life. Thus, all his promise which has been fulfilled in Christ are in the light of eternal life. We have it now and yet what the future holds for us. We are saved by a living hope.

Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. KJV

God justifies the ungodly. He placed his seal of acceptance and favour on that man who should perish eternally. In Christ, he inscribed an eternal hope towards that man who will believe that God is capable of saving him from sin and destruction without his effort but on God's grace. There is the blessedness of God in salvation which renders the efforts, righteousness and ability of man irrelevant and useless before his grace.

Our faith in the Lord was explained through the light of Father Abraham's justification by faith which God imputed unto him for righteousness. Romans 4:17-18 accounted for God's promise to Abraham by which he trusted and exercised a hope that elapse hope. That is, there was absolutely nothing reasonable to hope for or believed that what God has promised, he will still bring it to pass. Yet, Abraham, remained in hope. He continued to trust in the Lord who cannot lie. God counted it to him as righteousness because physically, there was nothing sensible to trust. However, he remained steadfast in trust before God who said he made him the father of many nations. Please read;

(as it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. Romans 4:17-18 KJV

Abraham kept his hope alive and he was justified by his faith in God. He received the blessedness of the man who can trust in God's words beyond what can be seen but only on what has been said. Romans 4:24-25 says that this kind of righteousness will be imputed unto us as we believe in God who raised Jesus from the dead. The one who was delivered for our offenses and raised for our justification.

Have you believed in Jesus? As for me, I have and I am not ready to wane in my faith in him, not now not ever. Therefore, God is my justifier. Nothing is laid in my charge, it is God who gave his begotten son for my life and will yet keep his word till the end of time. Is your hope in him still steadfast and sure?

TEXT: ROMANS 8:34

Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. KJV

For all who had placed their faith in Christ Jesus, are free from condemnation forever. John 3:17&18 establish this truth saying;

For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. KJV

Also, as touching the assurance of eternal life as a present reality and life of the believer which establishes that he or she can never come to condemnation, 1John 5:11&12 says; And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. KJV

As long as you have the Son of God (saved), you have eternal life. It is first a present day reality as you live on earth and continue to walk as a new creation in Christ Jesus. And you must recognise this as a present truth which separates you from an unbeliever and the world at large. You have eternal life in you because you are saved. The essence of your salvation is that you can never come to condemnation, because God has justified you in Christ Jesus, with the seal of eternal life.

Jesus describes this in John 10:27-29 saying; My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: and I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. KJV

No one can pluck you out of the Father's hand because the life of God resides in your Spirit. That life can not be condemned. It's pure, holy, undefiled. It is because you have eternal life now that you can hope for an unending life with the Lord as a future and eternal truth. So, eternal life is both possessive reality and a future reality. One set the pace for the other. If you don't have life now, you can't hope for life with God forever. I am glad because Jesus ever liveth, his intercession is to ensure that I remain grounded in the hope of the life in him and that which is to come. Are you persuaded?

PRAYER

Thank you Father. I have a living faith that goes beyond my present reality. The essence of my life is not in the clothes and shoes that I put on. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. KJV

Therefore, the hope of the gospel is the certainty of God's love. Which is not subject to times and seasons. His love remains unchanged forever. We can safely trust in God's love for us in Christ Jesus. Regardless of our present experience, either good or bad, wellness or sickness, trouble or calmness, joy or sadness, hungry or having great provisions; God's love abound all through our human living and days on earth.

God has asked us to trust in his love for us and hold unto it till the end of time. Thus, whatever we experience, we should trust in God's love which means that we are expected to express full confidence and assurance in our salvation, knowing that in it is God's love expressed.

In Romans 1:16, Apostle Paul declared that he isn't ashamed of the gospel of Christ: his words goes thus;; For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. KJV

In a more affirmative and possessive manner he also declared in 1 Corinthians 1:17 to the brethren at Corinth, he said; For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. KJV

Thus, Apostle Paul recognised that the gospel is about a person, who is alive and not dead. It is about God, who gave his everything in the body of flesh as reconciliation for the world. 2Corinthians 5:19 says; to wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. KJV

God, was the one in Christ Jesus. He did the work of reconciliation, in reconciling the world to himself, taking away all trespasses and commit to all who have been reconciled to him, the word of reconciliation. It is this word of reconciliation that encapsulates the message of hope in the gospel.

Thus, Jesus is preached as the hope of life. In his earthly ministry, he spoke affirmatively to the people saying; I am the bread of life. Except you eat my flesh and drink my blood, you do not have life in you. And he who eat my life and drink my blood has eternal life and I will raise him up at the last day. (John 6:53&54)

Their eyes were holden and their hearts were dull of understanding, thus his words were but an offense unto them. But glory to God, blessed are your eyes for see and your hearts for they perceive the will of God in Christ Jesus. You are saved because you have eaten his flesh and drank his blood. You partook of the bread of life by your absolute trust in him who died for you and rose again. Thus, you have eternal life and at the last day, Jesus, your savior will give unto you a body like his own. This is being raised from the dead. The right to share in eternity. Hallelujah!

Ephesians 1:21-23 KJV

These petitions are the very element required for stability and sustenance on the Christian Journey. Apostle Paul asked the Lord to equip the believers in Ephesus, which can be likened to you and I, who are saved with wisdom, knowledge and understanding to know the hope that is embedded in our calling as righteous ones in Christ. Then, more than a head knowledge, there is a revelation that must be expressed in our spirit, which will enable us to appreciate and adore God the Father for the intangible yet vivid life we have in Christ Jesus.

A believer will only be deceiving him or herself if he or she thinks that whatever he does is in vain. It's not brother, it's not sister. There is an account to be given before Christ, your lord and saviour.

2Corinthians 5:1-10 explained our physical body as a tabernacle. And also the desire that mortality be swallowed up in victory. However, whether we are in this earthly body or expect our heavenly tabernacle, we live unto the lord. It says that this desire and expectation that we have was wrought in us by God, who gave us the promise of immortality and life. Thus, verse 9-10 says;

Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad. 2 Corinthians 5:9-10 KJV

Thus, everyone of us as believers will appear before the judgement seat of Christ to receive the reward of the things we had done in our earthly body, whether it is good or bad. Thus, there is no vanity in God. In him is life everlasting. And we will be wise Christians to direct our lives in the light of his will daily, knowing that our Lord and saviour's voice is to say well done child. I am proud of you. There is no condemnation in him but you will receive as you have done. Therefore, do all things in his Excellency.

TEXT: TITUS 2:13

looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; KJV

We have a foresight. It is to look after the blessed hope and glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ. And since we have this hope or expectation, we purify ourselves even as he is pure. Hallelujah.

This isn't all, Apostle Paul went further, he said; who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. Titus 2:14 KJV

Jesus gave himself for us to redeem us from all iniquity and purify unto himself alone, a people zealous of good works. Truly, we have been redeemed from all iniquity. In Romans 12: 10-11 we are admonished further; Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; KJV.

There is need to live with unquenchable zeal for the Lord, as we love others, appreciate and honour ourselves as believers in Christ Jesus and also serve the Lord. Why do we have to do all these? It is because there is a blessed hope. This hope is anchored on a life style of love and service. We can't live in denial of our real life in Christ Jesus. Get on to work!

TEXT: 1THESSALONIANS 1:3

remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father; KJV

The Christians in Thessalonica received the gospel of Christ at a time when there was great affliction and persecution on all who believed in Jesus. Apostle Paul testified that even in this great tribulation and intense persecution, they embraced the love of God and became an examples to other believers in Macedonia and Achaia.

Thus, he referred to their disposition towards the message of the gospel as the work of faith, labor of love and patience of hope. Which means that the intensity of the afflictions they faced because they were willing to receive the mercy and grace of God has preached by them who brought the gospel to their hears, was not able to hinder them from the love of God.

Rather, in their affliction, they embrace the word of faith and were willing to continue to live as Christians. Specifically, verse 6 says; and ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost: KJV.

It is always impossible to give a sensible explanation to the experience a man has when he gets saved. The joy, the peace, the overwhelming comfort and the deep conviction that God is nearer than before supersede every other physical reality. Truly, salvation is a miracle! One that physical experiences and sensations can not truly articulate except by the expression of the Holy Ghost.

The saints in Thessalonica endured the present affliction because the gospel of Christ came with a great hope of life to them. Thus, 1thessalonians 1:9-10 says; For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God; and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come. KJV

They were formerly people who served idols. But by the mercies of God and power of his word, they received the gospel and lived with great expectation. They patiently endured the afflictions that came to them because of the hope that was ministered to them through the message of the gospel. The same hope we have today. We patiently wait for the son of God from heaven, the one who delivered us from the wrath to come. Our patience is anchored on this living hope.

Therefore, it is wise to pray and express the depth of our patience before God, in whom is our hope through which our patient living is built daily.

PRAYER

Thank you Father for in you I live and when I die, unto you is my life. Therefore, life and death is a win-win chapter for me. I ask that while I am living, you grant me the grace to patiently carry upon my heart the reality of the blessed hope in Christ. The message in Colossians 1:21-23 communicate this same truth, with the exhortation that we must remain firmly rooted in our new life in Christ Jesus. Let's read;

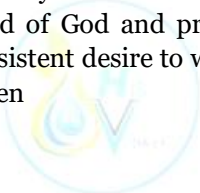

Therefore, Apostle Paul affirmed while he spoke to the believers in Thessalonica, that they are their hope and crown of rejoicing. He was simply saying that the believers in Thessalonica are the evidence of their labour in the gospel and thus are the crown that will cause them to rejoice when Jesus appear while the people remain steadfast in their faith.

The message is the same for us as well. You and I are the crown of rejoicing and hope of our pastors, leaders, and many others who have contributed to our faith in the Lord. Therefore, you cannot afford to be unstable in your faith. Your life is a living hope and your steadfastness in the Lord is as a hope and rejoicing before the appearance of Christ. Therefore, remain steadfast.

TEXT: 1THESSALONIANS 4:13

But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. KJV

The believer is at an everlasting advantage. More than you have come to understand the depth of God's goodness in your life, I want to inform you that there is so much hope in the faith of Christ which you profess. Apostle Paul addressed the Christians in Thessalonica as regards those that are dead, he said they should sorrow (mourn their dead) but not as though all hope is lost even though they are physically not in existence. He brought before them the reality that though a man dies yet, because he is born again, he lives forever.

Such was his revelation to the Christians in the church at Ephesus. As regards the riches in Christ Jesus, the Savior, Apostle Paul communicated that so many things have changed, especially the destiny and life of the man in Christ. Before, just as Christians in Ephesus, this was our reality:

Wherefore remember, that ye being in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands; that at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, *having no hope, and without God in the world:* Ephesians 2:11-12 KJV

But now, we have hope and we are with and in God. This is our established destiny. Let's read further; Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God; and are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone ; Ephesians 2:19-20 KJV

There is a citizenship whose identity surpass this earth, it transcend into heaven. There is an household that is more than an earthly union, it is the household of God, which started with the Apostles, who have gone ahead. This household is called **The general assembly and the church of the First born written in heaven** (Hebrews 12:23). It's more than a physical family, it is spiritual and will exist forever. Thus, when a Christian put away this earthly terbanacle (dies) he is still alive because he belongs to a spiritual household in which Jesus is the chief corner stone of the building. Hallelujah!

Ephesians 2:21-22 corroborates this and established that we are God's habitation, built up by the Spirit of God. Thus, we mourn and sorrow but not without hope. With this living hope in us, sorrow is quickly turn to joy and singing with a remembrance that we are yet alive in the Lord. Hallelujah!

TEXT: 1THESSALONIANS 5:8

But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. KJV

Ephesians 6:10-11 says to be strong in the Lord and in the power of his might, putting on the whole armour of God to be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. The believer has an armour to put on which enables him to be strong in the Lord and in his power.

In a similar light, as regards the expectation we have received in the Lord, a very potent gadget in the armour is needful. The hope of salvation as an helmet. Salvation here does not refer to deliverance from sin, we are saved already. 1Thessalonians 5:4-5 says; But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief. Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness. This is to further establish that the day of the Lord cannot take us unawares. We are instructed to live soberly, putting on the breastplate of love and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. This hope is a source of comfort to us, not of fear or panic as many tends to explain the coming of the Lord as if it's the believer's doom.

Rather, it's the beginning of our eternal reign in this world. The beginning of the ever abiding word of the Lord **The earth is the Lord and the fullness thereof....** Also, 1Thessalonians 5:9-10 affirm saying; For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep (alive or dead), we should live together with him. KJV

The promise of God in Christ Jesus are Yeah and Amen which means they are sure, true and fulfilled. I want you to read the text above calmly, I found the Amplified version more explicit. Please read, alongside verse 17;

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting comfort and encouragement and the good [well-founded] hope [of salvation] by His grace, comfort and encourage and strengthen your hearts [keeping them steadfast and on course] in every good work and word. 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 AMP

TEXT: 2THESSALONIANS 3:5

**And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ.
KJV**

Apostle Paul is known for his spirit filled prayers for the believers in different churches. For example we have an account of such prayer in Ephesians 1:17-23 & 3:14-21 (for the church at Ephesus), also in Philippians 1: 9-11 (for the believers in Phillip), Colossians 2:9-11 (for the church in Colosse), 2Thessalonians 3:3-5 (for the believers in Thessalonica), Romans 15:5-6 & 15. The list continue, however, these are a few examples of his consistent desire and petition before God to the believers in different city and country during his days.

It is not surprising that the element of his prayer to God for the church in Thessalonica as we have in our text above includes the heart of believers to remain directed towards the love of God and the need to patiently wait for Christ. It is true that the believer believed in the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus however, by experience Apostle Paul established that it is possible for believers to wane in their trust in God's love and begin to live as though the love of God has become scarce in their lives and walk with him.

Also, he affirmed that it is possible for believers to grow tired of being patient in waiting for Christ and become wanton and transformed by the world and its civilization. Thus, he asked the God who is the Savior of all men in Christ Jesus, to keep directing the hearts of the saved in his love and to equip with the necessary strength to trust and wait patiently for the Savior from heaven.

There are certain stage of your life, that you might have experienced either of this two things. Realising that your love for God is dwindling and also, you have grow weary of the things of God. Apostle Paul says the antidote to this feeling, which is fickle and a lie from the devil is to pray to God, asking that he should direct your heart to his love and the patient waiting for Christ. You must not remain in that atmosphere of an unchallant, unchallenged and uninspired attitude to the love of God in and for you and also to your expectation of the joy of salvation. By praying, you will get your hope fired up again and the Lord, who loved you with an eternal love will breathe on you afresh, such that there will be a fresh newness in your walk in and with him.

It's not time to give up but the time never to give up. God's love is for you and he is able to keep your heart stayed on him, while you are kept in his perfect peace. Hallelujah!

but Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end. KJV

As a result of the interaction that we have as men who are redeemed and possess the life of God here on earth; with the world which includes unsaved men, with different values and norms that negates the will and the desires of the God whom we trust and believe in, there is every possibility to become affected negatively.

However, there is provision for us in God's word. The word of God, written and put together in the Holy book, called the Bible, remain the anchor of our lives in the Lord. Therefore, it is important that we hold unto our hope in the Lord by not walking in unbelief or being deceived by the works of sin and its fancy results. Faithful is our God who has called us out of darkness into his marvelous light. Trust him, he is with you.

TEXT: HEBREWS 6:10

For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister. KJV

And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: that ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises. Hebrews 6:11-12 KJV

The texts above established that we have a God who doesn't forget all our work, labor and good deeds carried out in his name towards others, who are our brothers and sisters in faith.
